### **ICM Constitution and By-Laws – Guidance**

#### **Meetings of Council**

##### Article 12 (Constitution)

iv) All official delegates of Member Associations, the Board members and observers including all midwives belonging to a Member Association shall be eligible to attend meetings of the Council.

##### Article 12 (By-Laws)

4. At the beginning of the Council meeting lists of midwives, and other interested people wishing to observe the meeting, will be provided. Approval of their admission to the meeting venue will be taken as a third item of business. Observers are seated separately from the Council Delegates.

5. Members of Member Associations must have prior approval through their associations for attendance as observers at the Triennial Council meeting.

6. Other interested observers may attend Council meetings provided they apply to the Board for accreditation prior to its opening.
